Please send your child to school with closed-toed comfortable shoes, a bathing suit or something to do water play in, sunscreen if you want us to re-apply it (please apply before you arrive), a change of clothes, and items for rest time if staying full day. Also a lunch that follows USDA guidelines for full day children and a refillable water bottle with a leak proof lid is required for all children.

## CAMP THEMES - SUMMER 2025

### **Week 1: June 23 – June 26**

#### **A camping we will go!!**

We will bring the adventure of camping right into our classroom including a tent, campsite fire and a “river” to fish in. We’ll learn about frogs and pond life; and we’ll use marshmallows to paint with and to make our own smores with solar power!

### **Week 2: June 30 – July 3**

#### **Balls & Balloons!!**

We’ll spend the first 3 days investigating balls and balloons. We will explore gravity and use paddles we make to play “keepy-uppy” - everyone’s favorite game! Balloon painting and marble painting will be among our art explorations. On Thursday we will explore Independence Day! Lots of red, white and blue. We’ll make Independence Day crowns to prepare for the holiday and maybe even create some fireworks ourselves!

### **Week 3: July 7 – July 10**

#### **Sand, Sun & Surf!**

Will transport us away to a sunny, tropical beach. Art explorations will include sand painting, glitter crabs and many more. Beach balls will help us play beachy games, and it will be fun to explore sand dough. We’ll wrap it up with a swimsuit day and beach party!

### **Week 4: July 14 – July 17**

#### **Ocean Commotion!**

This week we journey beneath the sea and explore its many wonders! We’ll create an ocean in our sensory table, complete with sea life and a few treasures too. We’ll create sharks and puffer fish art. We’ll keep our bodies busy doing ocean animal movements and our little hands will be busy exploring “ocean slime”.

### **Week 5: July 21 – July 24**

#### **Summertime Treats!**

So many special treats are associated with summer! Each day we’ll focus on one lemonade, watermelon, ice cream and popsicles! We’ll play in our ice cream shop. We’ll create puffy ice cream art; lemon prints and watermelon lemonade playdough will delight our senses! Using simple recipes, we will make our own ice cream, lemonade and popsicles.

### **Week 6: July 28 – July 31**

#### **Mix it up!**

Concoctions – potions – mixtures galore! We’ll get our hands into all sorts of materials and see what happens when they are combined. Cornstarch and water; baking soda and vinegar; color changing slime are just a peek at the many creations our little scientists will make!

### **Week 7: August 4 – August 7**

#### **The Wonderful World of Water!**

There’s nothing more fun than a sprinkler on a hot day! Every day will be waterplay this week! We’ll investigate ice and we’ll play with sponges, basters and lots of other materials, seeing how the water reacts. And, of course, we’ll paint with watercolors of many types. A great way to wrap up the summer program!
